bring a diverse range of skills and knowledge to Shadows of Strength. We are committed to using our collective expertise to make a meaningful impact in combatting human trafficking and supporting survivors.

Within Shadows of Strength's first year, we have helped locate three high risk human trafficking victims. We have also listened to Victims, Survivors, and Family Members of whose loved ones are missing or are victims of Human Trafficking to gather intelligence on trafficking networks.

Our Team was also donated an amazing office space from one of SoS's Partners. Having a dedicated office space to conduct meetings can significantly support our efforts in combating human trafficking. It can provide a central location for team members to collaborate, plan actions, and strategize effectively. Utilizing the space for meetings ensures that important discussions take place in a professional environment conducive to brainstorming and decision-making. This type of infrastructure is crucial for organization, coordination, and ultimately making a greater impact in our fight against human trafficking.

Shadows of Strength donated to and found the time to support other non-profits. These non-profits include The Secret Place Home, Future Stars Sports Clinic, HER Foundation, Women Who Do Wonders, and Set Free Refuge.

Journey:

Our journey has been filled with both challenges and triumphs as we embarked on our mission to combat human trafficking. One of the key insights we gained early on was the gap that existed between local and federal law enforcement agencies and survivors of human trafficking. This gap hindered effective communication and coordination, making it more difficult to provide the necessary support and assistance.

In response, we developed an investigative victim-centered approach, ensuring that survivors were at the forefront of our efforts.

Collect. Identify. Rebuild.

To enhance our capabilities, we leveraged cutting-edge technology and intelligence gathering techniques, such as OSNIT (Open Source Network Intelligence), HUMIT (Human Intelligence), GeoSpatial Analysis, and Operations.

These tools allowed us to collect valuable information and intelligence, enabling us to locate Human Trafficking Victims, and identify and

But our work didn't stop at investigation and intelligence gathering. We also recognized the importance of empowering survivors and helping them rebuild their lives.

To this end, we started a partnership with Alpha Female Tactical to provide free concealed carry weapon (CCW) classes to survivors.

By teaching them self-defense and equipping them with the tools to protect themselves, we aimed to empower these individuals to regain control over their lives and feel safe again.

We formed other partnerships with like-minded organizations such as Uncommon Valor, The Secret Place Home, Tappan Consulting, A&R Tinting, and B3 Milsim.
